VISUALLY INSPECT THE ROLLER FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- BAT WINGS AND STOP RINGS DO NOT HAVE CRACKS
- SHAFT COLLARS ARE SECURE AGAINST BEARINGS
- BEARINGS DO NOT HAVE DRAG
- ROLLERS MOVE FREELY
- SHAFT IS STRAIGHT, FREE FROM CRACKS AND FIXED TIGHTLY IN THE TOOL
- INNER WHEEL HOUSING IS FREE OF CRACKS
- MATERIAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER AND PATENT NUMBERS ARE VISIBLE AND LEGIBLE
